
It is Time to Register for Annual Conference!

Registration is now open for the inaugural Tennessee-Western Kentucky Annual Conference on **June 15-17, 2022!** This year, you will have a **choice to participate in person or online.**

Helpful things to know and decide before you register:

- Everyone needs to register whether participating online or at Brentwood (or both). Also, guests need to be registered if they plan to attend in person.
- No food will be sold onsite during the annual conference. However, you may order and
 pre-pay for an onsite meal when you register. (Note: The BUMC Youth Cafe will only have
 beverages for purchase during the annual conference.)
- You will have the opportunity on the form to add a registration and lunch order for an additional voter or guest.
- UMCOR representatives are presenting an overview of *Connecting Neighbors* at lunchtime. You may want to order a boxed lunch to eat during that on the day you plan to attend.
- Registration for childcare and day camp is separate from conference registration see below for the link.
- Reservations for the Clergy Retiree Luncheon are to be made directly with
 Melinda.Parker@twkumc.org. Invitations were sent to retirees last week by email or in the mail. Contact Melinda if you did not receive an invitation.
- If applicable, please indicate specifically on the form what type of assistance you may
 need during the annual conference such as language translation, large print documents,
 wheelchair access, handicapped parking, etc.
- If you are clergy, you will be asked whether you plan to robe and sit with clergy at the
 Service of Licensing, Commissioning, and Ordination on Thursday night. Be sure to
 register for this so the appropriate number of seats can be reserved for robed clergy.

A Smart Phone or Device with Data is Needed to Participate

Everyone eligible to vote will receive a Voting Code from GNTV in late May or early June and will be expected to use that code to vote on a smartphone or tablet - even if you are at Brentwood. Please bring a device that uses data - *not wifi* - as there will not be wifi availability at the church. (A smartphone will be your best option, however, a tablet or laptop with data access would work.)

Those voting members participating from another location will sign in to a private Zoom Webinar in order to vote, ask questions, and be recognized to speak.

Getting Recognized to Speak

Whether you choose to participate online or at Brentwood, to ensure that all voting members have an equal opportunity to be recognized to speak - **both those online AND in-person -** will need to use an online form to request a spot in the queue. (Onsite, there will be tellers to assist you with this.) The bishop will only recognize those who are in the online queue.
