

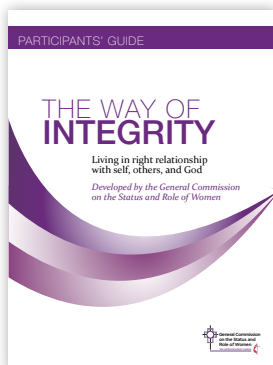

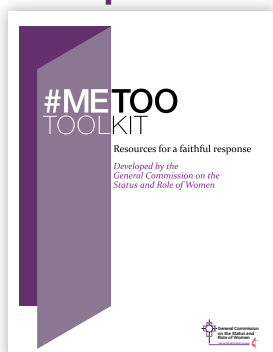
The Way of Integrity

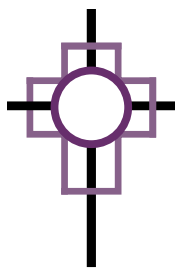
#MeToo Toolkit: A Faithful Response

The *#MeToo Toolkit* has been developed by the General Commission on the Status and Role of Women (GCSRW) which joins others around the world in addressing the prevalence and problem of sexual misconduct throughout our Church and society. The #MeToo movement, founded by Tarana Burke, an African-American activist, has seemed like the Spirit of Truth moving through our world, uncovering that which has been hidden in plain sight for decades. The toolkit offers resources of printed materials, links to important websites, as well as suggestions for participatory conversations designed to encourage dialogue to help people identify, understand, and respond to the reality of sexual misconduct. All of these resources are intended to help guide people to a deeper understanding of the problem of sexual misconduct and beliefs of The United Methodist Church in response to this problem.

Whispers with Stones

Whispers with Stones is a five-minute animation aiming to create social and behavioral change around sexual harassment in the church and society. Directed by Chocolate Moose Media, the video can be shown to churches, small groups, and Sunday schools to address the sexual misconduct that happens in our congregations and world. Along with each video is an accompanying guide to be used by a leader to facilitate conversation after the viewing of the animation. This resource has been translated into ten languages. The video has won multiple international media awards.



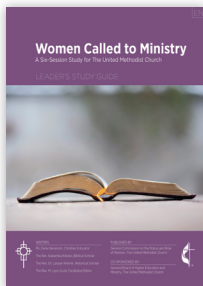
God of the Bible

God of the Bible is a study designed for small groups and churches to explore the names, images, and ways in which God has been revealed. This study introduces an approach to expansive language and invites participants to explore God's revelation through a lens that is faithful to multiple perspectives.



Women Called to Ministry

Women Called to Ministry is a United Methodist Bible Study for small groups and local churches on leadership, ministry, and learning to work together. This study digs into the biblical foundations for our United Methodist commitment to the full inclusion of women and men in the church, celebrates the ministry of many historical women, and invites each participant to explore their own call to leadership in the body of Christ. Produced by GCSRW to mark the 50th anniversary of women's ordination, the study is designed primarily for use by local congregations. *Women Called to Ministry* is available in English, Spanish, Korean, Spanish, Portuguese, French, and Russian.
