Clarification about Voting and Online Participation

During business sessions, everyone will vote electronically using a voting code. Also, anyone who wants to speak or ask a question will do so using an online form - *even those folks who are at Brentwood*. This way - in our hybrid setting - everyone has an equal opportunity to be recognized by the bishop to speak.

If you are participating from home, you will need a computer with an internet connection. If you will be attending at Brentwood UMC, **please bring a smartphone or a tablet that allows you to get to the internet using a DATA plan** - not WiFi. (With so many people in the sanctuary, we want to avoid overloading Brentwood's WiFi capacity.)

You are encouraged to attend a **GNTV online training** session to learn (or refresh your memory) about how to vote and be recognized. These sessions will be on at Noon on May 31 and on June 13 at 7 p.m.
