EVENT/TRIP CHAPERONE

Responsibilities:

- Pray for the youth and leaders at the event/trip, before, during, and after the event/trip.
- Take part in any strategic meetings with the pastor and the YMT and other volunteers, both preceding the event/trip and during the event/trip itself.
- Prepare thoroughly for the trip/event by reviewing any schedule and lesson plan (varies from event to event) provided by a member of the youth ministry staff.
