#### **Lay Servants**

- Every 3 years <u>must</u> complete an approved refresher course.

## **Certified Lay Servants**

- Serve, support, and minister in their local church and beyond; through district or conference projects and programs and community;
- Have taken at least one Advanced Course
- Submit an annual report of activities
- Every 3 years <u>must</u> complete an Advanced Course to maintain certification.

## **Certified Lay Speaker**

- Same requirements as a Certified Lay Servant
- Plus additional courses approved in the 2016 Book of Discipline and/or advanced courses approved by the Conference Lay Servant Ministries Committee.
