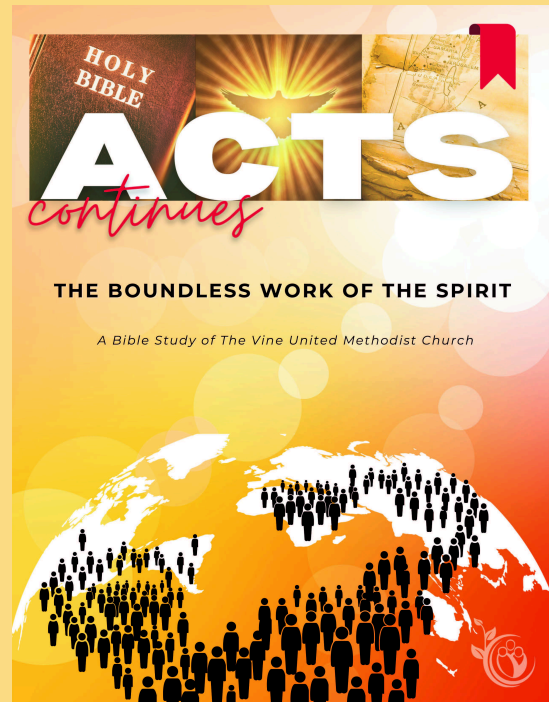
Begin the Annual

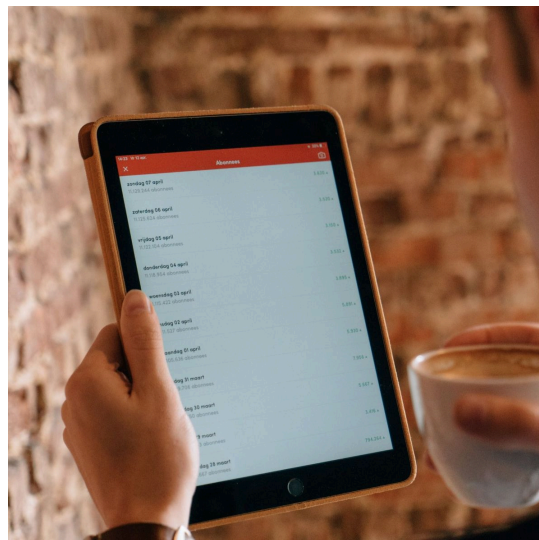
