Licensing	\$500.00	We pay CCLI and OneLicense an annual fee each year based on our worship attendance. This allows us to legally stream our worship services. Each service will be \$250 next year.
Youth Choir Music	\$1,200.00	Anthems cost approximately \$3 each. We have 40 members in the choir and hope to order 10 new anthems next year.
Youth Choir Tour	\$35,000.00	Historically, we've spend around \$33,000 each year for choir tour. This number includes all expenses, including transportation, lodging, food, and activities. Most of this cost is covered through student payments and fundraising as noted above in the income section.
Children's Choir Music	\$100.00	We are purchasing 20 copies of a musical for our spring performance. Books cost approximately \$5 a piece.
Handbell Music	\$600.00	Anthems cost approximately \$3 each. We have 20 members in the choir and hope to order 10 new anthems next year.
